Purpose

EarlyON Centres must develop policies and procedures for safe sign-ins including establishing how physical distancing can be maintained.

Policy

Pre-registering for programs and services ahead of time helps to promote safe and timely sign-ins for children and families.

Procedure

Communities Together for Children EarlyON Child and Family Centre will:

- Display signage at the entrance explaining hand hygiene, physical distancing, symptom screening and usage of masks (as applicable);
- > Use signage/markings on the ground to direct families through the entry, where to wait, and how to exit;
- Encourage one-way traffic flow throughout the space;
- ➤ Encourage hand hygiene by providing hand sanitizer containing 60%-90%alcohol content at the entrance with signage demonstrating appropriate use;
- Conduct frequent cleaning and disinfection of high-touch surfaces; and
- ➤ If storage for personal items is required (e.g., strollers, diaper bags, etc.), we will encourage physical distancing (through signage) when accessing the space as well as regular cleaning.
- > Staff will assist families signing in on the KeyON system and disinfect any touched surfaces between users.

Policy and Procedure Review

Communities Together for Children EarlyON will review this policy monthly and recognize
that this policy may be amended as needed in response to continually evolving
circumstances during the COVID-19 pandemic.
